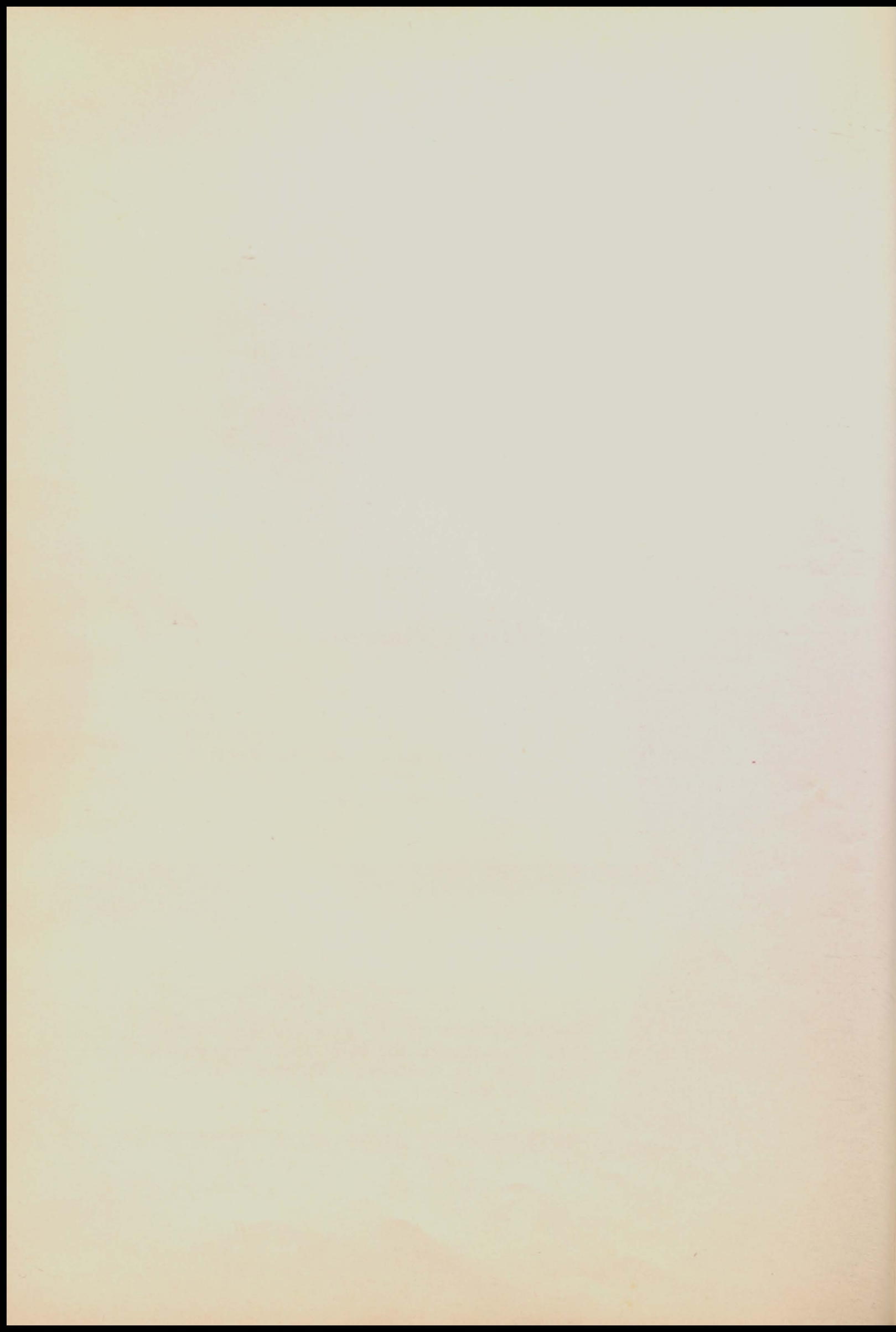


Mrs Florence Hubbard

There's Gim, Fritz and Dianne in top position;

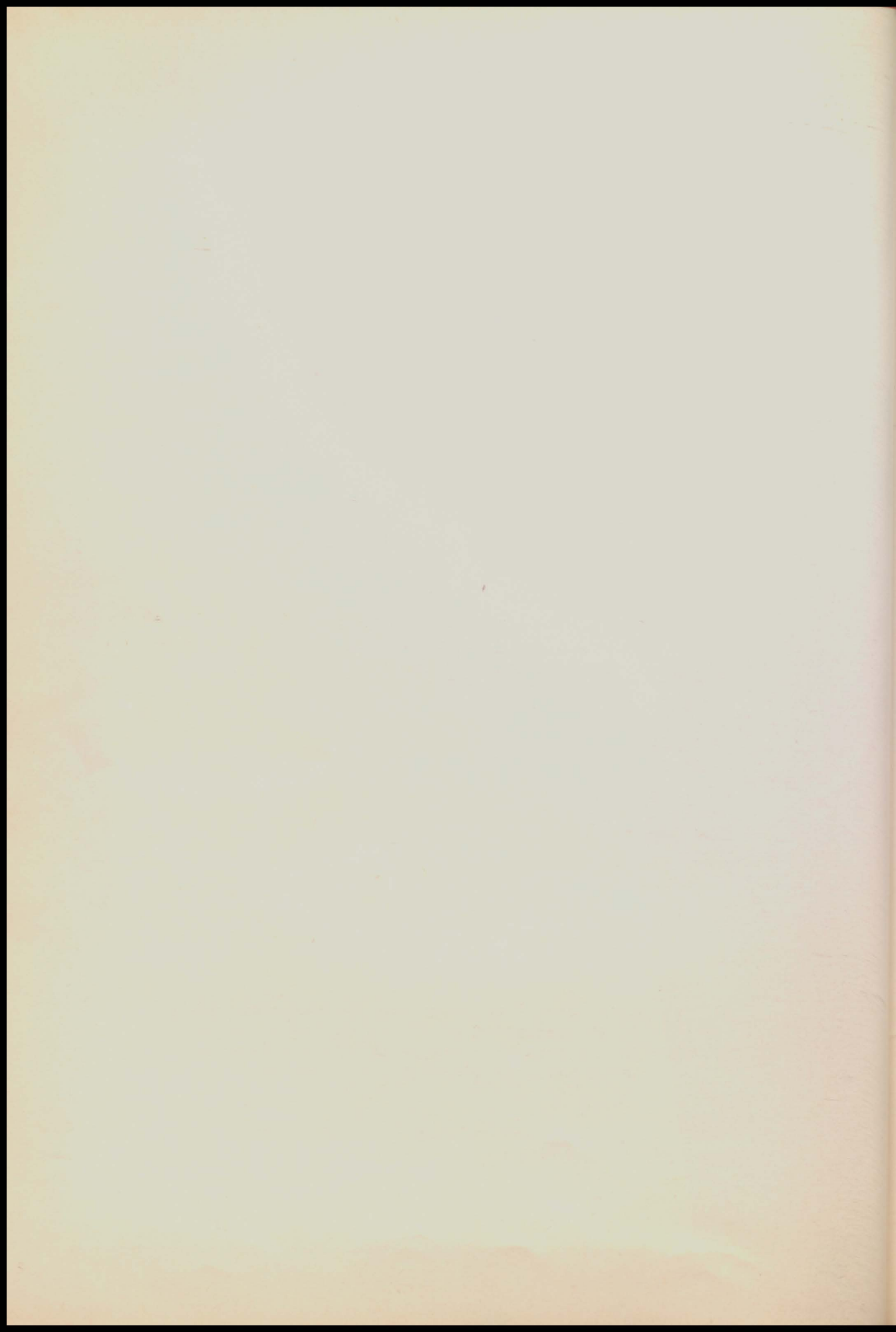
Claire's the nurse and Winston the farmer,

Senior year: we've attained caps and gowns;

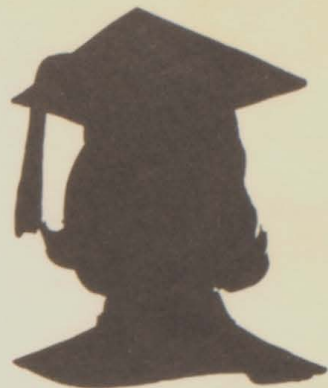
We've been very happy for the past four years,

During the year we lost Reginald Mongeur, Alan Murray, and Helen Stone.

Our Freshmen year was the first year that Mr. Leister was the Principal of the Rochester High School. Other members of the faculty were: Mr. Lary, Mrs. Eloise Dutton of Bethel, Miss Lillian Marsh, Mrs. Florence Hubbard, Mrs. Carolyn Simmons of Bethel, and Mr. Richard Ellis of South Royalton.

The Sophomores presented a Freshman Dance in our honor. It was the first year there was not a Freshman Reception. In place of the Freshman Reception, we toiled for a day in the school forest, pruning trees, etc.

In our Sophomore year we had only twenty members in our class. We had lost Cathy Boutelle and Steven Tracy, and we gained Ernest Lanpher.

There was a change in the faculty that year. Mr. Edward Hall replaced Mrs. Dutton and Mrs. Frank Buss replaced Miss Marsh. Our class was the highest class in total per capita sales in the 1962 magazine drive and therefore won twenty - five dollars for our class treasury.

On June 11, 1963, our class put on the Junior Prom. It was one of the most beautiful Proms that has ever taken place in Rochester High School, and needless to say, was a great success. The theme of the Prom was "Moon River". Stephen Kittredge and Janet Eells were crowned King and Queen.

Also during June, 1963, Fritz Paul and Larry Curtis, and Dianne Ainsworth represented our school as delegates to Boys' and Girls' State. Claire Bailey was the alternate for Girls' State.

In 1963, we began our Senior Year with seventeen students. We had lost Royce McIntyre and gained Marcia Hill, at the end of the year Barbara Hill was to join us again.

Fritz Paul wills his ability to act to Buddy Ainsworth, although you're doing fine already.

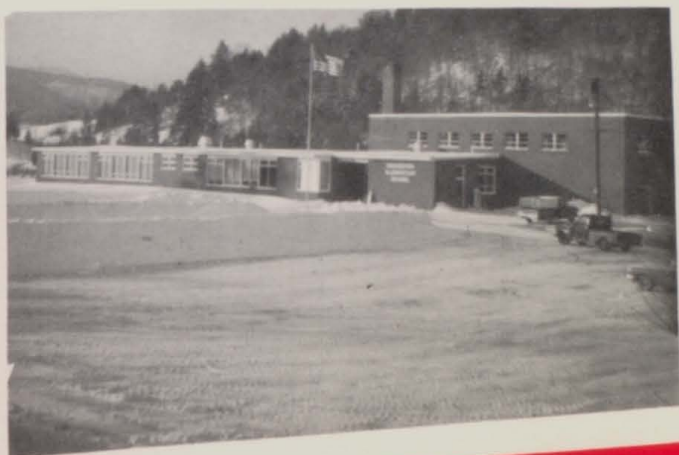

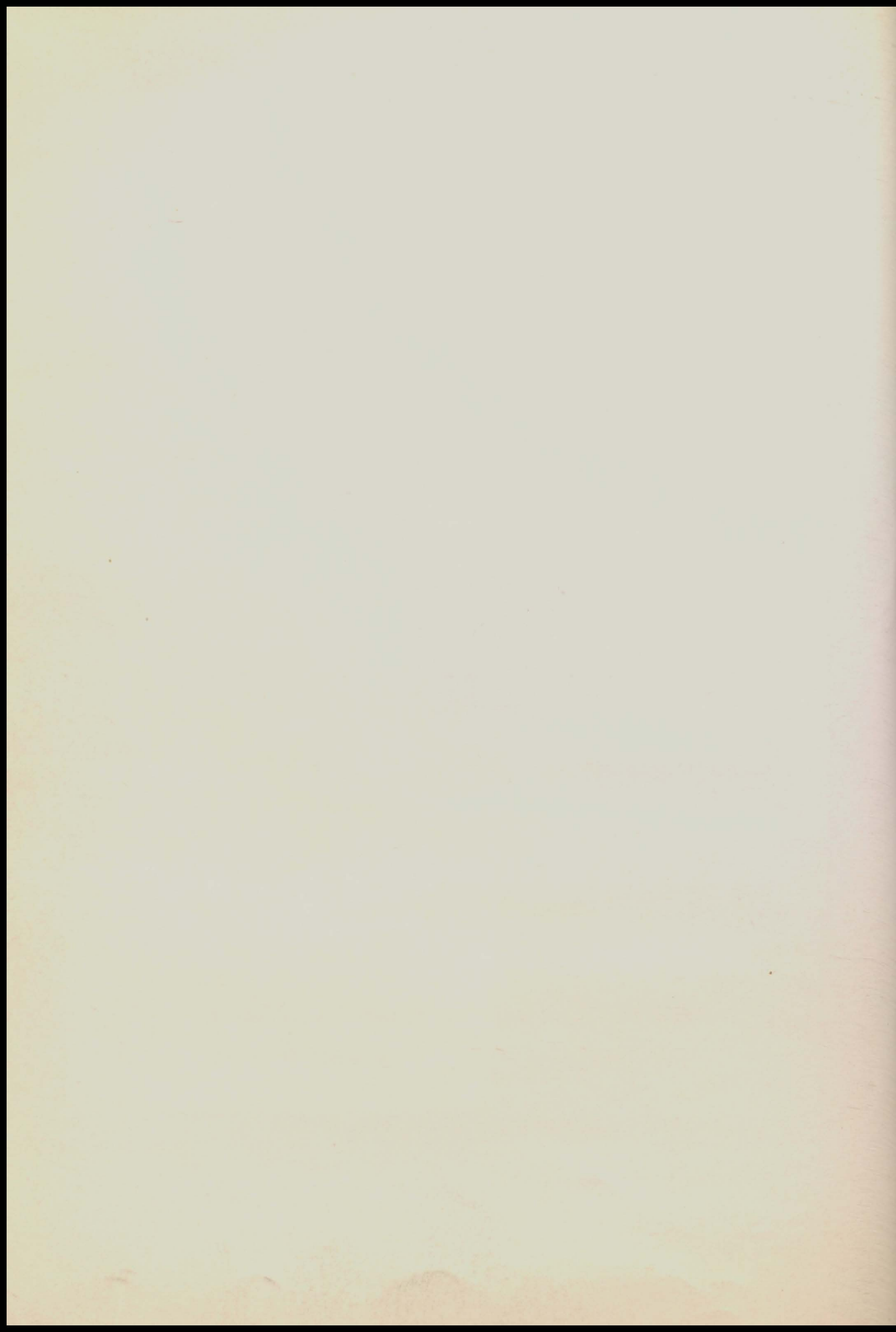

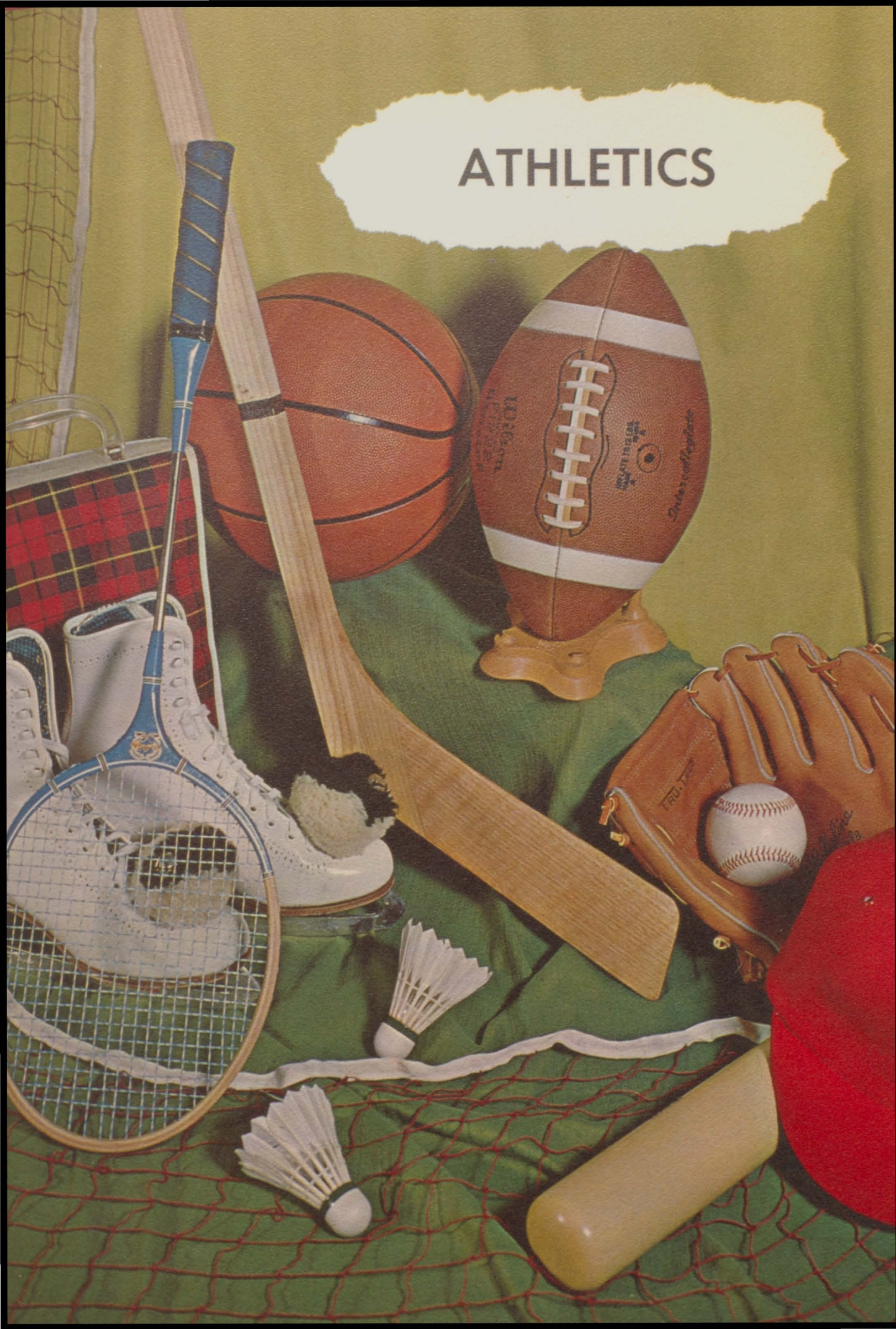
Old Building finished in 1895
