Our Junior year we gave the prom, our class cut-ups were Lynn and Tom. Our Junior Prom was really keen: Doug our King, Beth our Queen.

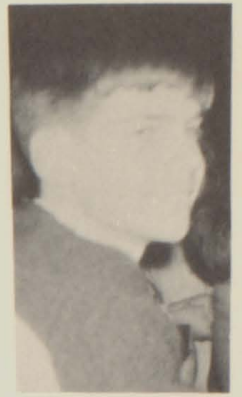
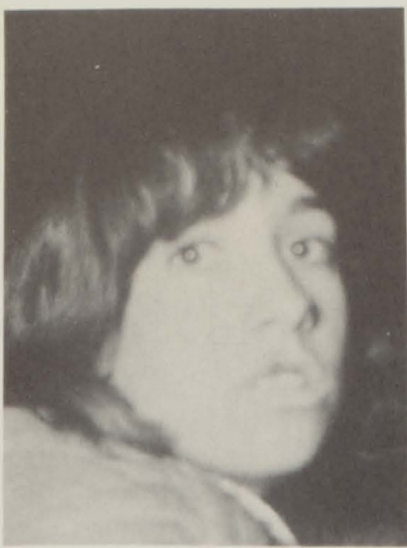

Although our future remains in a haze we will never forget our high school "days". (Days?)



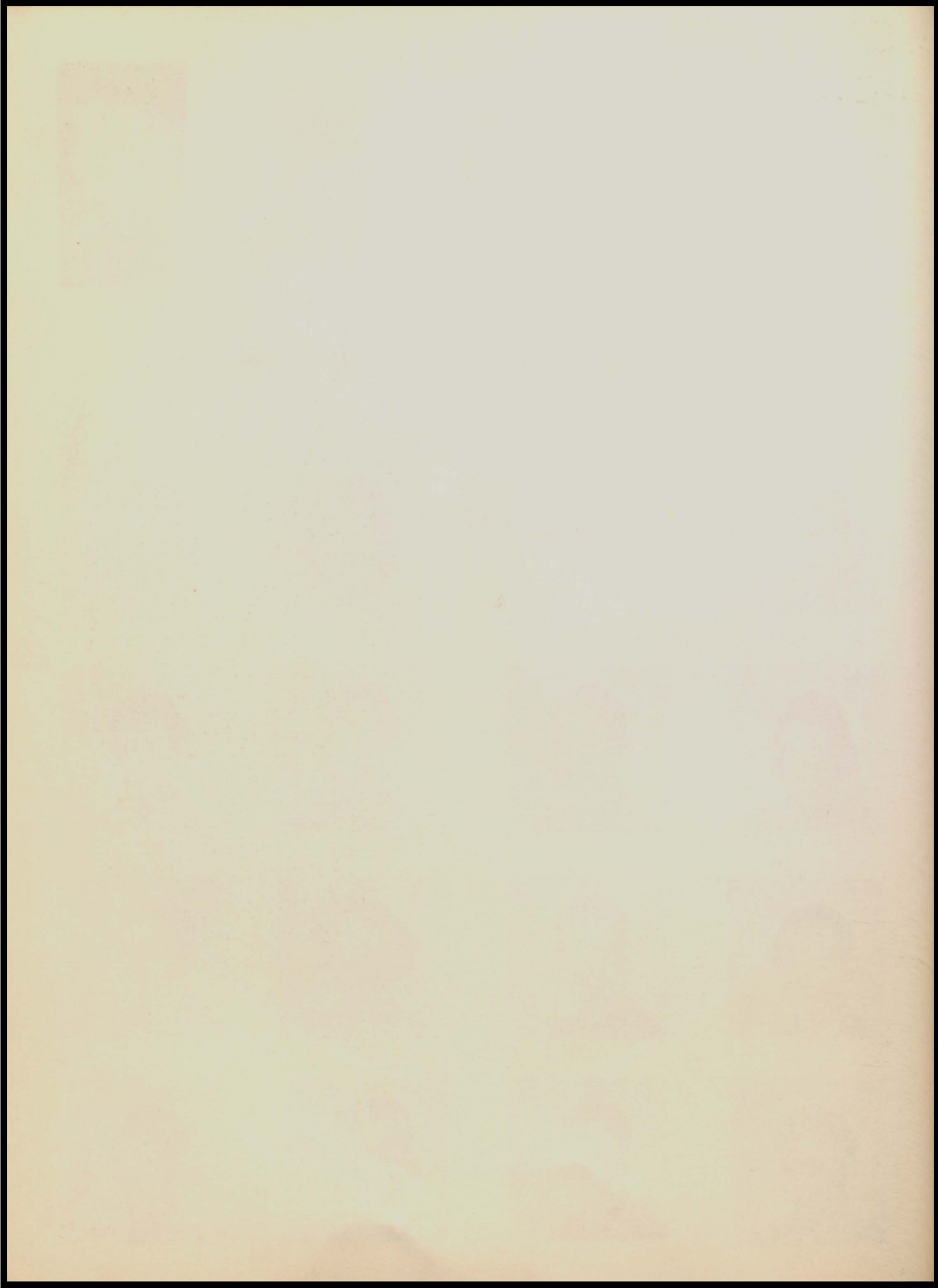
