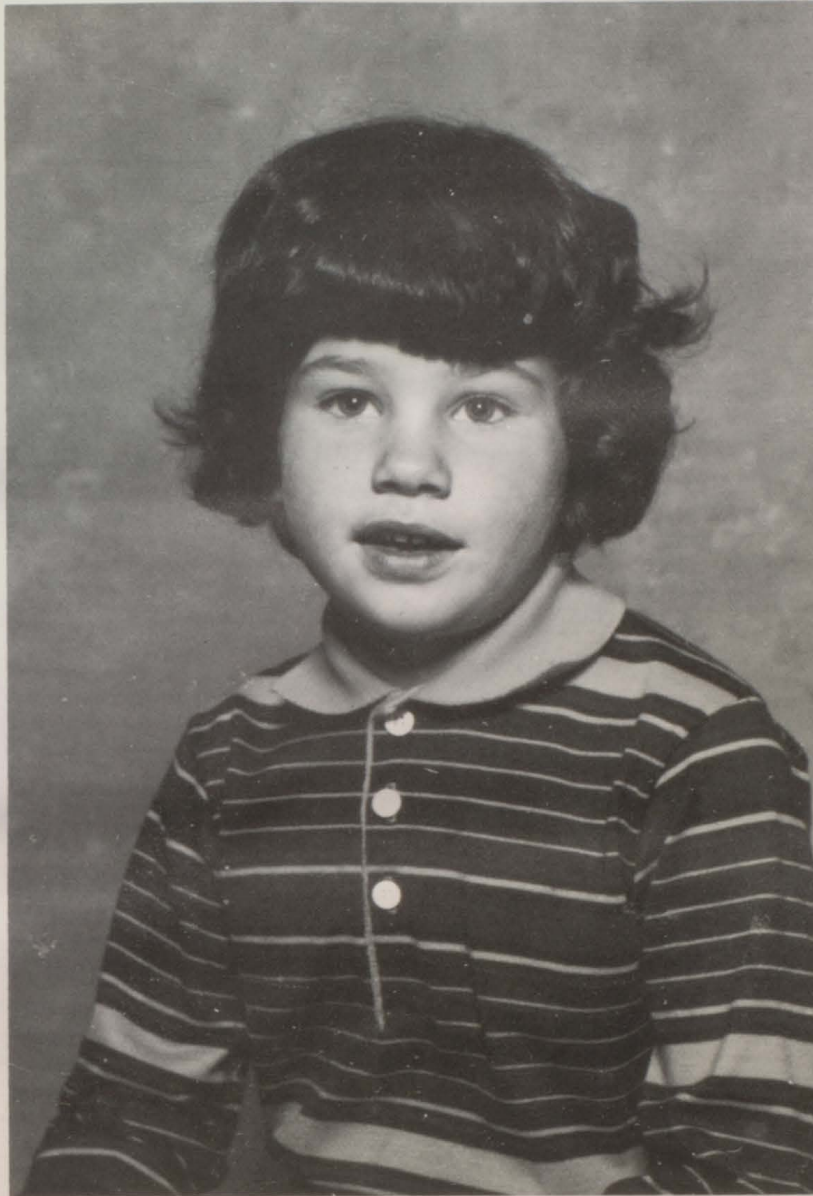








## In Memoriam

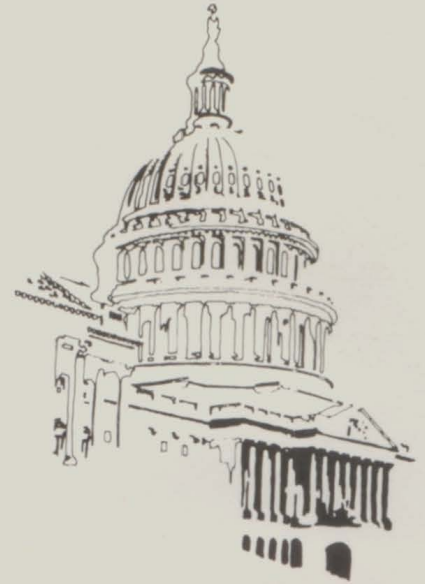




## Close Up — A View of Washington
