Some of the activities were hula-hooping, counting peas, eating pudding blindfolded, bobbing for apples, and singing and dancing.











The 1980 Softball season was a very successful one, ending with a record of 9-5. Add to this the runner-up spot in Division III of the State Touranment.




JV BOYS


