Outdoor Graduation in Rochester
(As reported by Martha Slater 6-22-95 in The Herald)



Saturday June 17, was Graduation Day in Rochester. The sun shone brightly and a warm breeze billowed the blue and white caps and gowns of the Rochester High School class of 1995 as they made the traditional procession across the park behind class marshals, Beth Donnet and Danny Sanz, to their seats in front of the Civil war monument.

Class salutatorian Alyssa Wells spoke movingly of the "global problems that affect the delicate balance of our fragile planet" and the "personal sacrifice and personal action" needed to "dramatically change the way we live." She called on her fellow classmates to show "responsibility, commitment, desire, and sacrifice... We are the class of 1995 and we must make a difference."

RHS teacher, George Moltz, read a speech written by class valedictorian, Elizabeth Miller, who is spending a year as part of an exchange student program in Indonesia and so was unable to attend her own graduation. She urged her classmates to be adventurous. "Everything is worth a try & sometimes those things change your life forever."

After the singing of the national anthem, Justice of the Peace Java Hubbard administered the Freeman's Oath to many of the graduates. This was followed by the announcement of awards and scholarships.

Ricci Rushton was the winner of the William Kent Award, the White River Credit Union Scholarship, the Stephen Bloch Memorial Award, the Elizabeth Ann Murray Award, the Bernard Campbell Memorial Scholarship, the Roxanne Sue Curtis Bowen Award, and the Artists Guild Award.

Deanna Weeks received the Music Award, a Route 100 Lions Club Award, the Conceptions Unlimited Award, the Kirkpatrick Memorial Scholarship, and D.A.R. Good Citizenship Award.

The Martin Farms Award went to Becky Kennedy. Elizabeth Miller was the recipient of the Salvation Army Scholarship, the Tim "Toodles" Billings Award, and the RHS Service Award.

The V.F.W. Howard B. Perry Post Award went to Alyssa Wells, as did a Route 100 Lions Club Award, the Faculty Award and the Edwin Harvey Scholarship. Joseph Bowen won the Bethel Rotary Club Scholarship, the Court Saint Anthony #1231 Catholic Daughters Scholarship, and the Joseph Prelas Award.

Heath Crowley, who is joining the U.S. Army, was presented with a facsimile check representing the amount of scholarship money he will be receiving from the army for continuing his education. Josh Prelas was the winner of the Dick Hubbard Service Award, the Kyle Joseph Lizotte Award, and the Damian Sleath Award.

The Special Faculty Award was presented to Carl Curtis. It was also announced that Ricci Rushton and Joe Bowen had both won Business Management Program Scholarships at the RAVC Awards Night on June 8.





Floyd Scholz, an award-winning sculptor, former U.S. Olympic team athlete, author, musician and Hancock resident, gave the charge to the class. In his well-received remarks about the power of positive thinking, Mr. Scholz noted that "the key to being successful is to choose something that you really love to do... If you approach problems with a positive attitude you are already halfway there."

Reminiscing about his own days in high school when a football coach told the tall, skinny boy that he "didn't have what it takes to become an athlete," Mr. Scholz told the graduates how he didn't let that discourage him.

"The two easiest words to say are, 'I quit,' but five years later, I made the Olympic track team."

As he traveled around the world competing, he told himself over and over that "winners never quit and quitters never win."

Urging them to 'prove the critics wrong,' Floyd quoted a favorite uncle ("The only time you'll see success come before work is in the dictionary,") and advice given by his father ("You get what you give in life... give respect and learn from other people.")

He closed his remarks with a tribute to the "genius" of the late Mike Kinsley of Hancock.

"He didn't have a college degree, but he was one fo the greatest teachers I'll ever know... When I was around him, I kept my mouth shut and my ears open."

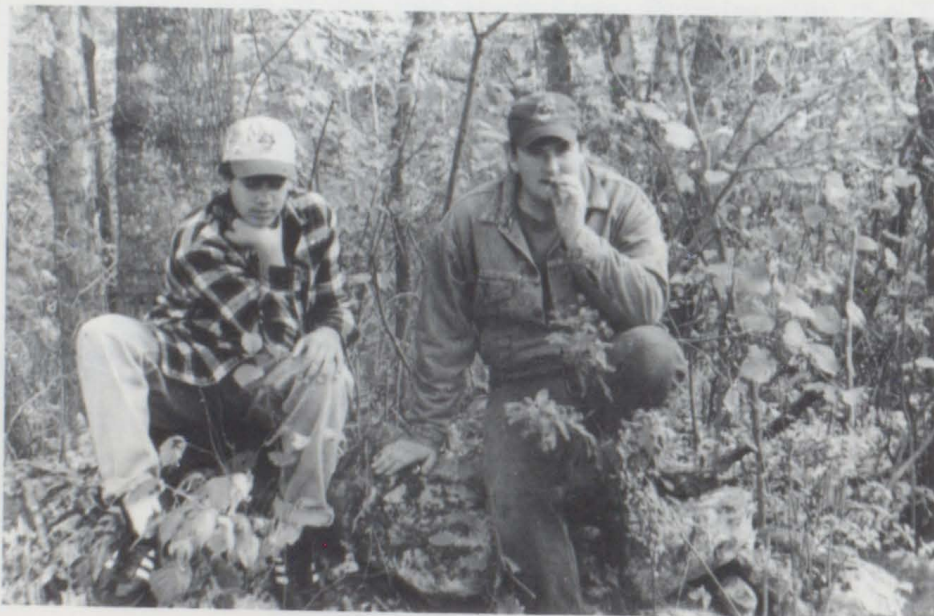
Finally, it was time for the big moment when diplomas were presented and Alyssa Wells led the class in the traditional "turning of the tassels." Smiles blossomed and arms pumped the air as the class of 1995 recessed across the park with cheers from the audience and the rolling of the old school bell ringing in their ears.
