# Rochester High School's Students Get Diplomas

Leslie Papa received the Court Saint Anthony #1231 Catholic Daughters Scholarship. The Edwin Harvey Memorial Award went to Ethan Moulton.

Professor Bryon drew appreciative laughter at many points during his humorous anecdotal charge to the class, as he joked that "Jessica already gave my speech," and commented on many things he had observed and admired about the graduates during the graduation ceremony.
