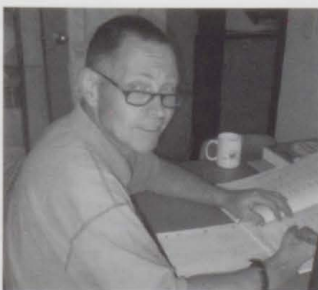

Rochester High School Graduates 10 At Its 110th Commencement

The rain stopped and the clouds parted just in time the morning of Saturday, June 19 to allow Rochester High School's 110th commencement to take place in its traditional spot, on the Rochester Park. This was the first RHS graduation for Principal Bob Gray, who put his own stamp on the ceremony by starting a new tradition; that of having the teachers and members of the school board march in prior to the graduating seniors. 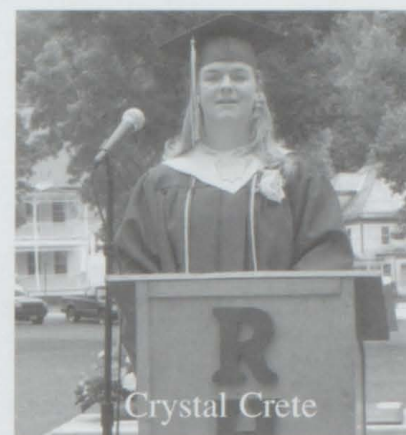

Noting that "our differences are what make our class so strong," she illustrated that point with a fanciful tale of what could happen with her classmates 25 years in the future, as they helped each other out with a problem. Sherman ended her remarks with Mark Twain's famous advice: "Always do right. This will gratify some people and astonish the rest."

After Java Hubbard and guest speaker Secretary of State Deb Markowitz administered the Freeman's Oath to those seniors who were 18 and wished to register to vote, it was time for the announcement of the awards.



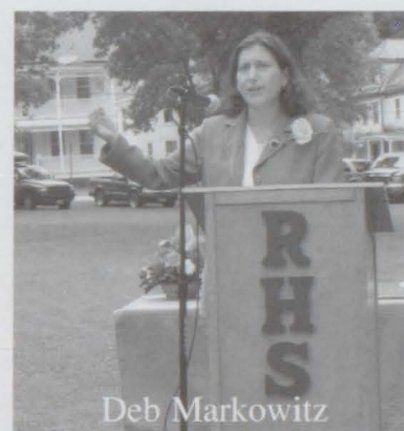

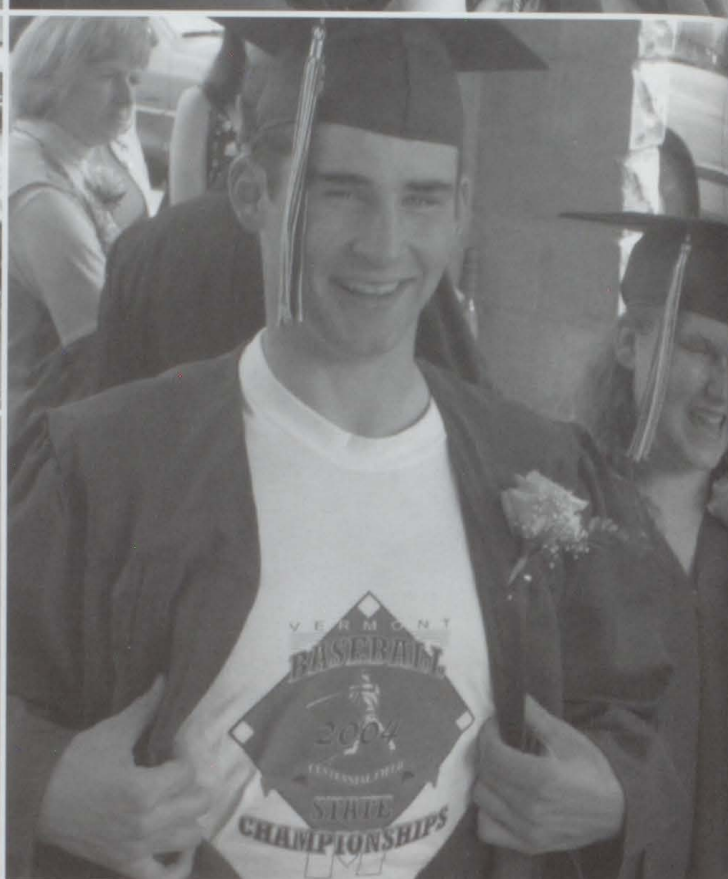
The thrust of Markowitz's advice to the Class of 2004 was that they should be willing to risk failure to achieve their goals.

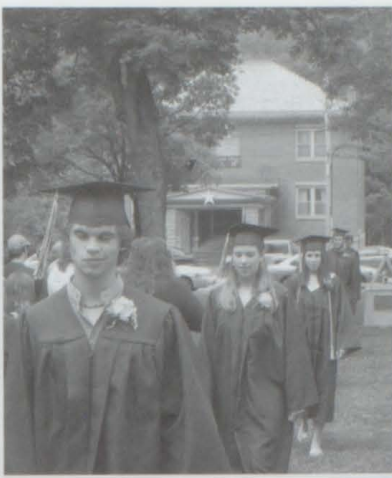

Following Markowitz's speech, diplomas were presented by school board chairman Becky Donnet and new WNWSU Supt. Tim Mock, and Principal Gray declared the seniors "officially graduated." Tassels were turned and mortarboards flung skyward as the RHS Class of 2004 headed westward across the park to ring the old school bell and receive hugs and congratulations from their family, friends, and neighbors.





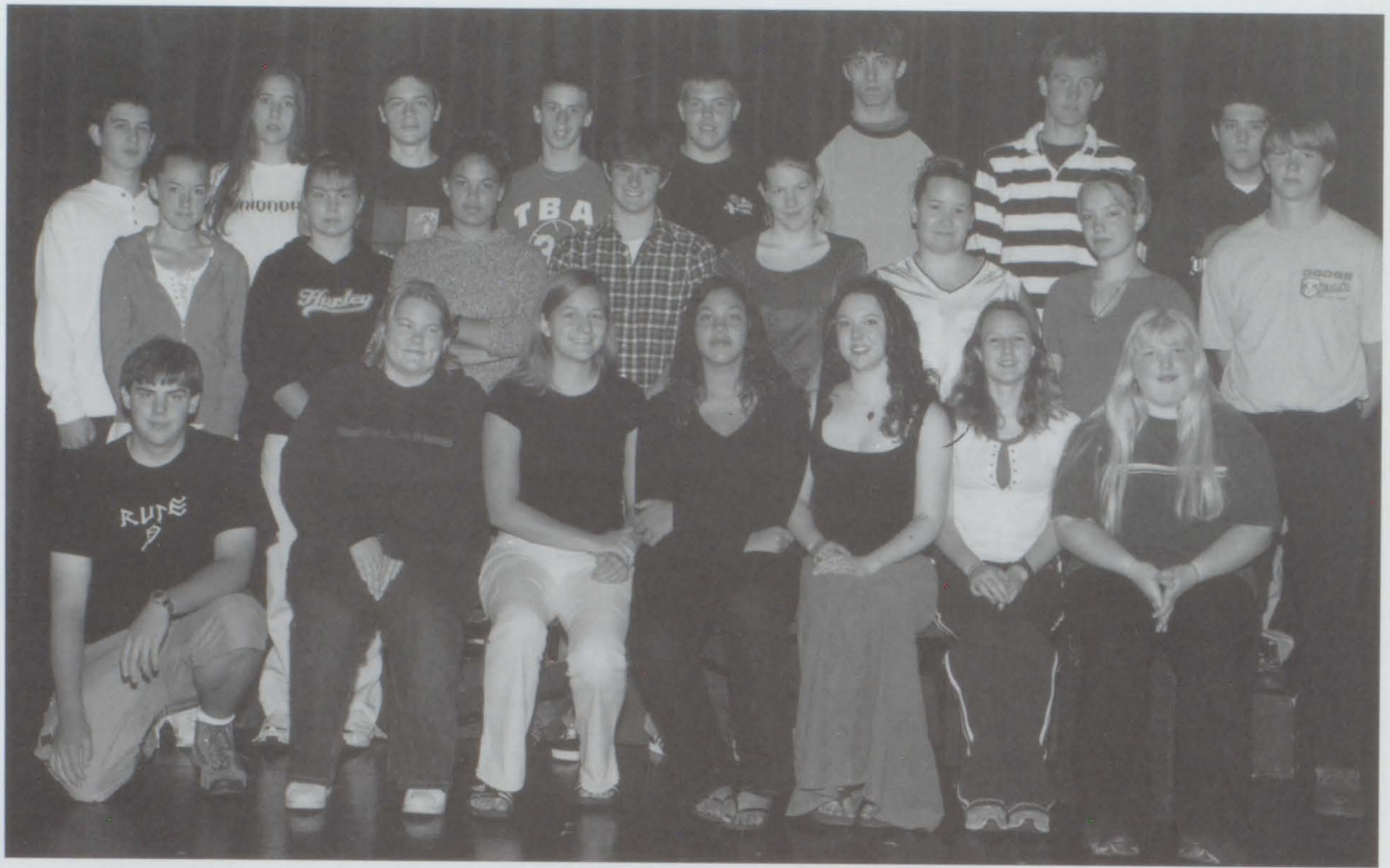

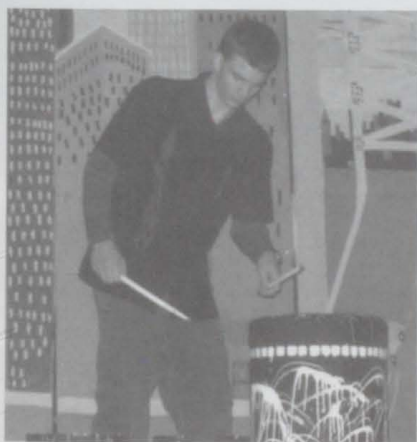
