"His love and enthusiasm for life touched all of us," noted his wife, Wendy. Teaching was his passion. He loved working with students of all ages. His career began at the Stetson School in Barre, Massachusetts, a residential treatment center for boys. In 1980 Dave became the Science teacher at Rochester School. In 1993 Dave received the Award of an Outstanding Vermont Teacher at a UVM ceremony. When he retired from the classroom in 2004, he worked in the Special Ed Department, of the Elementary School.


He had the special opportunity to teach his own daughters, Karen and Sarah, and was thrilled to present them both with their high school diplomas. Karen is now a teacher herself, crediting her dad with her choice because he could always find something good in a person, and it was in his respectful nature to help [that person] discover [his/her] self-worth and uniqueness.

Dave Allen became a member of the Boy Scouts of America on his 11-year-old birthday and held numerous leadership and scoutmaster roles, including summer camp positions and as Camp Director at Camp Collier and Mt. Norris Scout Reservations. Dave was a recipient of the Silver Beaver Award from the Green Mountain Council, the highest award given to volunteers.

He stated his philosophy as: "I believe a teacher must stimulate the heart as well as the mind. I believe the teacher's task is to equip a child with the knowledge he needs for life, the sensitivity he needs to enjoy life, and the curiosity he needs to enjoy learning the rest of his life."

We thank Dave Allen for his wisdom and his caring about each of us. He touched our lives immeasurably!

Mr. John R. Poljacik, Principal, warmly welcomed the overflowing crowd of family, friends, and community enthusiasts. Dr. Valerie F. Levitan introduced both the Salutatorian, Christine Meagher, and Valedictorian, Samantha Mishkit, referring to their respective personal accomplishments and their supportive families and wishing them continued success.

Referring to her year in Thailand as a Rotary Exchange student, Christine talked about "getting outside your comfort zone ... doing something that you do not usually do or something that you do not necessarily feel comfortable doing....
