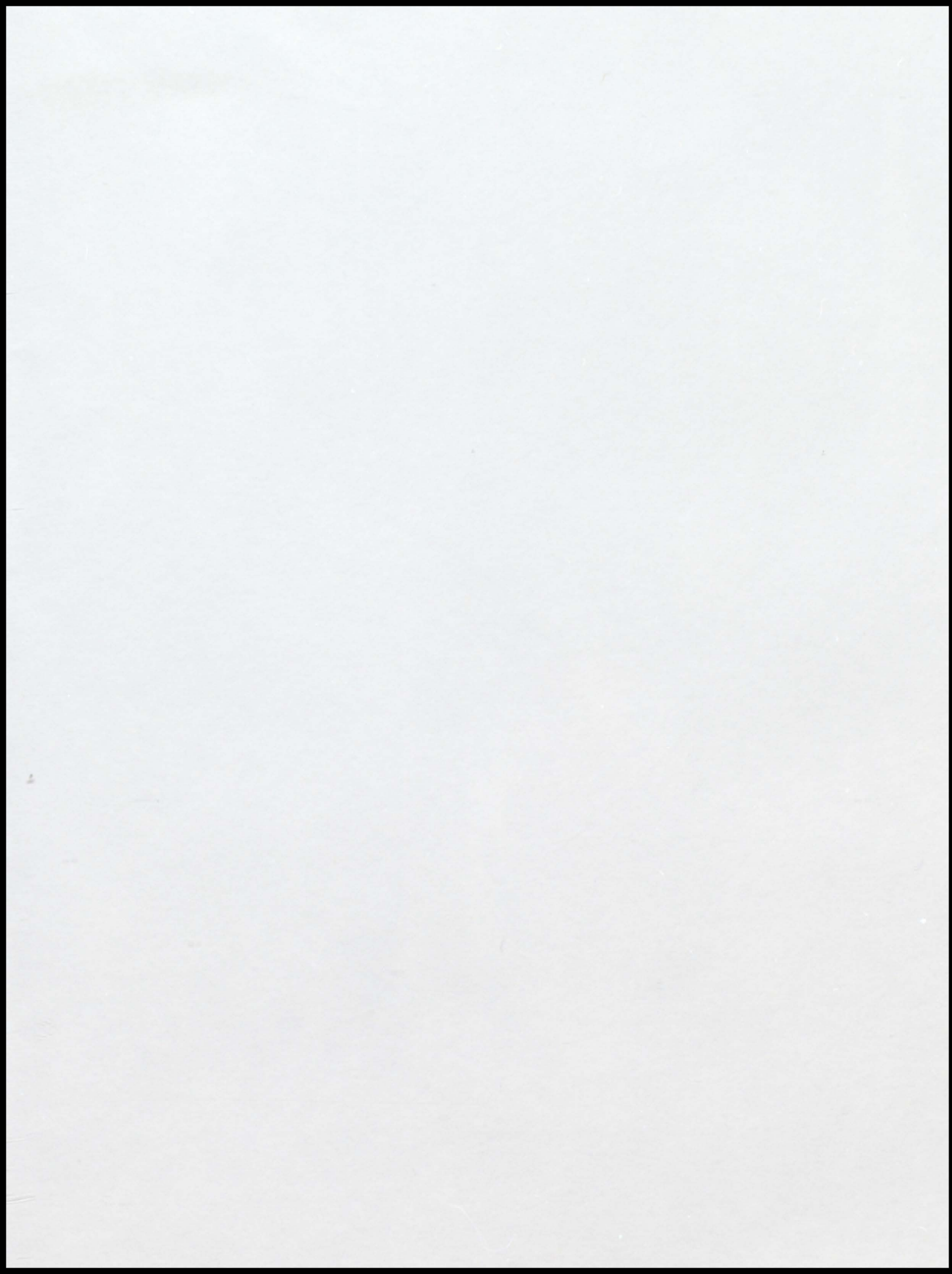


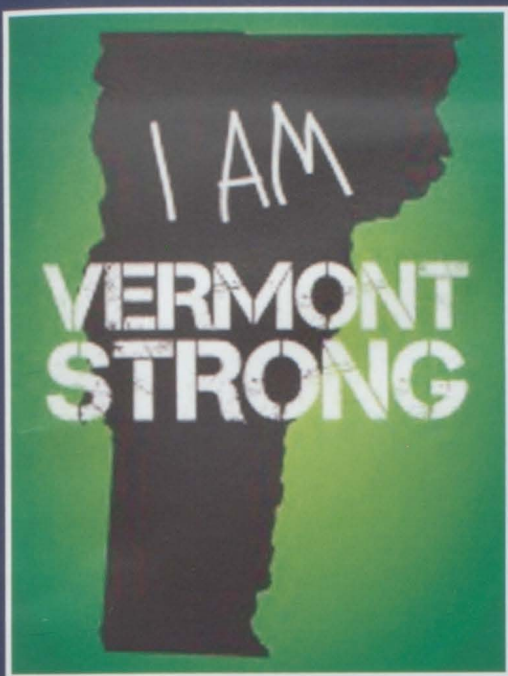

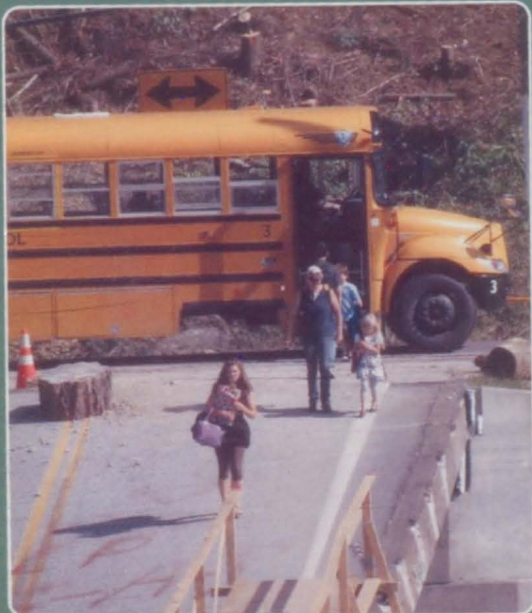
The rain began before

of the world.



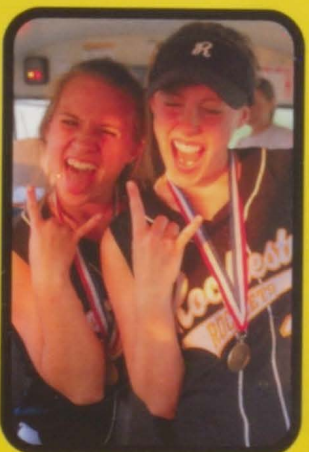
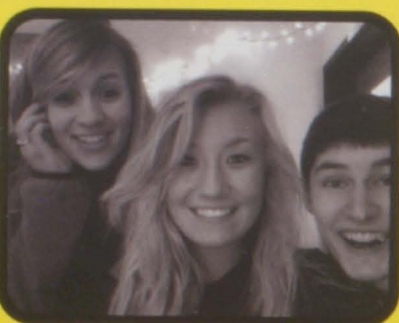
By the time we finally

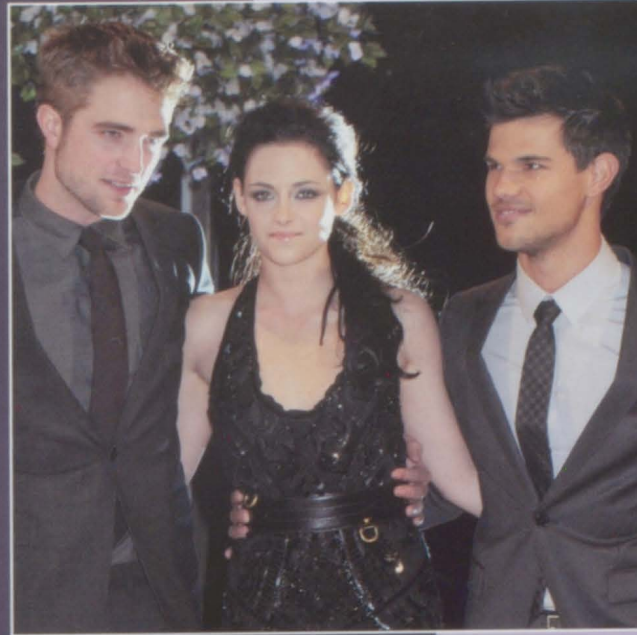
