



#### Tim Pratt

#### Rochester Rockets - Vermont Division IV State Champions!

From start to finish, it was a magical season for the Rochester Rockets during the winter of 2012 - 2013.

The boys opened the year by winning the Beanpot Game against our rivals from Whitcomb, and then swept to the title in the Bob Abrahamson tournament in Proctor. Throughout the winter, the Rockets were rarely tested, posting an impressive 19-1 record and only falling to the Division III state champions from Williamstown. Led by junior point guard Pavin Parrish, who shattered the school scoring record previously held by Dean Pierce, Rochester's combination of intense defense and explosive offense proved impossible for opponents to surmout.


Earning the # 1 seed in the tournament, the Rockets clobbered Cabot in the playdowns, and eeked out a heart-stopping win over Blue Mt. in the quaterfinals to advance to the Barre Auditorium.

Awaiting Rochester in the semi-finals were the defending state champions from Twinfield, who had given the boys a most competitive game during the regular season. However, Coach Kingsbury's squad was up to the task, pasting the Trojans 77-61 and advancing to the title game against West Rutland. The Golden Horde played a strong first quarter, but then crumbled against the Rockets' relentless attack, and the boys in blue coasted home with an well-earned championship. It was Rochester's first boys' basketball title since 1993.


